INTRODUCTION

- A. Seeing is Believing (I Believe because I See) or Believing is Seeing (I See because I Believe)
- B. Sometimes things happen that are so amazing that, unless you see it...
- C. Many of us have attempted to share our testimony and others did not believe them _____

JESUS RESURRECTED FROM THE DEAD

- A. Jesus told Thomas three times
 - 1. Luke 9:21-22
 - 2. Luke 9:43-45 > Jesus would: Suffer / Be Rejected / Be Crucified / Resurrect on the Third Day
 - 3. Luke 18:31-34
- B. Thomas should have known
 - 1. However, Thomas did not know
 - 2. More accurately, Thomas did not understand
 - 3. Even more accurately, Thomas was not supposed to understand
- C. Others told Thomas three times
 - 1. Mary Magdalene Mark 16:9-11, *He appeared first to Mary Magdalene... She went and told those who had been with Him...when they heard that He was alive and had been seen by her, they did not believe.*
 - 2. The two disciples from the road to Emmaus Mark 16:12-13, *He appeared in another form to two of them as they walked... And they went and told it to the rest, but <u>they did not believe them either</u>*
 - 3. The ten disciples **John 20:25**, *The other disciples therefore said to him, "We have seen the Lord." So he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and put my hand into His side, <u>I will not believe</u>."*
- D. Thomas did not believe _____
- E. How do you believe without understanding?

SEEING IS BELIEVING OR BELIEVING IS SEEING

A. For Thomas, Seeing is Believing _

- 1. Unless I see the nail prints in his hands
- 2. And put my finger in the nail print
- 3. And put my hand into his side, I will not believe
- 4. Thomas needed visible, physical, and tangible evidence
- 5. Are you waiting for visible, physical, and tangible evidence?
- B. For us, Believing is Seeing
 - Matthew 12:38, ³⁸ Then some of the scribes and Pharisees answered, saying, "Teacher, we want to see a sign from You."
 - 2. John 4:48, ⁴⁸ Then Jesus said to him, "Unless you people see signs and wonders, you will by no means believe."
 - 3. 1 Corinthians 1:22, ²² For Jews request a sign, and Greeks seek after wisdom
 - 4. Jesus said, Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed
