# **TEXT: JOHN 21:1-14**

## **TITLE: MEETING JESUS AGAIN**

### **INTRODUCTION**

- A. What is the highest level of maturity? (Dependence, Independence, Interdependence)
- B. Money can be a stumbling block
  - 1. Jesus Matthew 19:21-23, <sup>21</sup> Jesus said to him, "If you want to be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me."<sup>22</sup> But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions.<sup>23</sup> Then Jesus said to His disciples, "Assuredly, I say to you that it is hard for a rich man to enter the king
  - 2. Jesus Matthew 6:21<sup>21</sup> For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
  - 3. **Paul 1 Timothy 6:7-10**, <sup>7</sup> For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out...<sup>9</sup> But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and harmful lusts which drown men in destruction and perdition.<sup>10</sup> For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- C. Additionally, I believe being intelligent, competent, innovative, etc. can be a stumbling block
- D. Peter had stumbling blocks
  - 1. **Peter rebuked Jesus Matthew 16:22**, <sup>22</sup> Then Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him, saying, "Far be it from You, Lord; this shall not happen to You!"
  - 2. Peter expresses willingness to sacrifice for Jesus John 13:37, <sup>37</sup> Peter said to Him, "Lord, why can I not follow You now? I will lay down my life for Your sake."

  - Peter rejected Jesus John 13, <sup>8</sup> Peter said to Him, "You shall never wash my feet!"
    Peter defended Jesus John 18:10, <sup>10</sup> Then Simon Peter, having a sword, drew it and struck the high priest's servant, and cut off his right ear. The servant's name was Malchus.
  - 5. Peter denied Jesus John 18:25, <sup>25</sup> Now Simon Peter stood and warmed himself. Therefore they said to him, "You are not also one of His disciples, are you?" He denied it and said, "I am not!"

### JESUS KNOWS WHAT TO DO FOR YOU

- A. Peter and six other disciples went fishing (Peter James and John were fisherman by trade)
- B. Peter failed at what he was called to and went back to what he was used to \_\_\_\_\_\_
  - 1. They got in the boat, fished all night and caught nothing
  - 2. Peter was now failing at what he was used to
- C. Jesus knew what to do for Peter
  - 1. Jesus, "Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some"
  - 2. When they did, they were not able to pull the net in because there were so many fish in it
- D. Jesus knows what to do for you
- JESUS CAN DO IT BETTER THAN YOU
  - A. When they came to shore, they saw fish cooking over a charcoal fire and bread
  - B. Jesus could do it better than Peter
  - C. Jesus can do it better than you
