A.	For some, Christianity is the Gospel of Prosperity
B.	For others, Christianity is the Gospel of Poverty
C.	 I Timothy 6:17, ¹⁷ Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy. Ecclesiastes 2:24, ²⁴ Nothing is better for a man than that he should eat and drink, and that his soul should enjoy good in his labor. This also, I saw, was from the hand of God.
