TITLE: AM I MISSING AN INTERSECTION WITH SOMEONE?

A. Is eternal life a matter of my action – what I do or not do?
B. No. It is a matter of righteousness – that is, being right with God – through faith in Jesus
1. Romans 14:17, for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy
in the Holy Spirit.

- 2. Romans 4:2, 3, ² For if Abraham was justified by works, he has something to boast about, but not before God. ³ For what does the Scripture say? "Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.
- 3. **Romans 3:21, 22**, ²¹ But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, ²² even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe. For there is no difference
- C. The evidence that I am right with God through faith in Jesus is me relationship with others
- D. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., We are caught in an inescapable network of mutuality, tied in a single garment of destiny. Whatever affects one directly, affects all indirectly.

KEEP THE COMMANDMENTS

- A. Jesus dismissed the flattery, "Only God is good"
- B. Jesus addressed the question, "Keep the commandments"
 - 1. **Leviticus 18:5**, You shall keep my statutes and my ordinances; by doing so one shall live: I am the Lord
 - 2. **John 14:15**, ¹⁵ "If you love Me, keep My commandments.
 - 3. **1 John 2:3**, ³ Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments.
- C. The man asked, "Which ones?"
- D. The 10 Commandments are divided into two sections
 - 1. The first four commandments assists in nurturing and enhancing our relationship with God
 - 2. The remaining six commandments assists in nurturing and enhancing our relationship with each other
 - 3. Jesus recited the six commandments relating to human interactions

- B. "All these things I have kept from my youth. What do I still lack?"
 - 1. You shall not murder
- 4. You shall not bear false witness 5. Honor your father and *your* mother
- 2. You shall not commit adultery
- 6. You shall love your neighbor as yourself

3. You shall not steal

C.	The man's attention was on what he was not doing. Jesus refocused his attention to what he needed to do
	1. GO , sell your possessions, and give the money to the poor (and you will have treasure in heaven)
	2. COME , follow me
D.	The evidence of my COMING to follow Jesus is my GOING to assist others
	1. 1 John 3:16, 17 , ¹⁶ By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay
	down our lives for the brethren. ¹⁷ But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and
	shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him?
	2. 1 John 3:18 , ¹⁸ My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed [action] and in truth.
	3. 1 John 4:20, 21 , ²⁰ If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not
	love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen? ²¹ And this
	commandment we have from Him: that he who loves God must love his brother also.
