	There is a difference between fighting against and fighting with
	African and Biblical ancestors' view of names
	Why would God change your name?
E.	When God changes your name, it does not diminish nor negate your original name. Rather, it augments your original name
F.	It may not be a literal name. Rather, a spiritual sense that God is doing something different in you and with you that sets your life on a different course

A.	The name, Jacob, means Supplanter, Trickster
B.	Supplanter
	 To usurp the place of, especially through intrigue or underhanded tactics One who struggled/wrestled to get what belonged to someone else
C.	Jacob was independent and self-sufficient, struggling to gain whatever he wanted by any means necessary
D.	Genesis 25:24-26 – Jacob was born into this world wrestling – holding onto Esau's heel
E.	Genesis 25:29-34 – Jacob manipulates Esau out of his birthright
F.	Genesis 27:1-40 – Jacob stole Esau's blessing
G.	Genesis 27:1-40 – Jacob deceived and dishonored his father, Isaac
H.	Genesis 27:36, Is he not rightly named Jacob? For he has supplanted me these two times. He took away my birthright, and now look, he has taken away my blessing!
I.	Lest we be too hard on Jacob are you wrestling against God and humans?
ISRAE	
A.	The name, Israel, means One who struggled with God, and humans, and prevailed
В.	Jacob wrestled with a heavenly being 1. Jacob had developed his own plan and procedure for meeting his brother, Esau 2. They wrestled all night until dawn 3. The heavenly being dislocated Jacob's hip 4. Jacob continued wrestling until he received what he wanted (his own blessing) 5. Jacob's name was changed to Israel 6. Jacob was also changed physically and spiritually
C.	Jacob is transformed from one who wrestled against God and humans (Jacob) to one who wrestled with God on
	behalf of humans (Isaac)
D	Are you wrestling with God for the benefit of humanity?
