TEXT: ESTHER 4:1-17

TITLE: IF GOD BRINGS YOU TO IT, GOD WILL BRING YOU THROUGH IT

INTRODUCTION

A. "Why should I put my life in jeopardy for someone else?"

B. "Therefore, I will mind my own business and take care of mine."

- C. However, sometimes I am called to:
 - 1. Speak on behalf of and for the benefit of those who cannot speak for themselves
 - 2. Act on behalf of and for the benefit of those who cannot act for themselves
 - 3. Advocate on behalf of and for the benefit of those who cannot advocate for themselves

I MAY HAVE NOTHING TO DO WITH THE PROBLEM

- A. Haman
 - 1. Out of his anger because Mordecai would not bow or pay homage to him
 - 2. Devised a plan to kill all of the Jews
- B. Today
 - 1. Because of others' misplaced emotions (anger, envy, jealousy, fear, competition, etc.)
 - 2. Plans are devised to hurt and destroy certain groups of people

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO WITH THE RESOLUTION?

- A. The easy answer is, "Nothing."
- B. However, is that the right answer?
- C. Mordecai sent a message to Esther to do something _
 - 1. He gave her a copy of the order to kill the Jewish people
 - 2. He told her to go to the king (uninvited)
 - 3. To beg for mercy and plead for her people

D. Esther's objection ____

- 1. There is one law for people who come before the king without being invited they are put to death
- 2. And, I have not been called to come before the king for 30 days
- 3. Esther was only considering her well-being
- E. Mordecai's correction
 - 1. Do not think that in the king's palace you will escape any more than all the other Jews.
 - 2. For if you keep silent at this time, relief and deliverance will rise for the Jews from another place, but you and your father's family will perish.
 - 3. Yet who knows whether you have come to the kingdom for such a time as this?
- F. The need for redirection
 - 1. My position and location will not isolate me from the damages of the problem
 - 2. God is going to resolve the problem. The question is:
 - a. Will I remain silent, do nothing and be damaged by the problem?
 - b. Will I speak, act, advocate and be used by God to save others and myself
 - 3. And, perhaps that is the reason why I am "here"
