Many of us are aware that the Supreme Court has overturned Roe vs Wade, thereby eliminating the constitutional right for women to have an abortion. Independent of which side of the issue that you stand, know that it will greatly influence the lives of women all throughout the country.

As individuals will discuss and debate this decision over the next several months, following are two considerations that I offer to be included in the debate.

First, I believe it is important to draw a distinction between someone who is choosing to living a sexually promiscuous lifestyle, choosing not to use a contraceptive, becoming pregnant and choosing abortion because a child interrupts her lifestyle, and someone who has been sexually molested by a family member / family friend and/or family associate, and someone who was raped.

Whereas it is easy to stand back and point our fingers in judgment, what would we do if it were us or our daughters and granddaughters? Chances are, we would not point our fingers in judgment, rather, we would respond with love and compassion.

Second, many Conservatives are taking a victory lap as they have suggested that they are standing on a moral high ground as it relates to abortion. Please do not be deceived. In general, Conservatives are not pro-life. They say that they are pro-life, however, in reality they are pro-birth. Let me explain:

Conservatives generally tend to be Pro-Life. That is, they are against abortion and believe that all pregnancies should be continued to full term and the babies born into this world. Additionally, Conservatives generally tend to be against social policies that affect and influence the lives of children once they are born into this world. Consequently, they support life before the child is born, however, after the child is born, the child is on her own.

Progressives generally tend to be Pro-Choice. That is, they support abortion and a woman’s right to choose if she will permit her pregnancy to continue to full term and have her baby born into this world. Additionally, Progressives generally tend to support social policies that affect and influence the lives of children once they are born into this world. Consequently, they may not support life before the child is born, however, after the child is born, they will support him.

Therefore, I pray that we do not get caught up in the surface level, narrowly focused, guilt ridden views that will be presented from both sides and prayerfully, intentionally and holistically consider where the opportunities are for love and ministry to occur
