	TITED. EM OWERED TO EM OWER
	DDUCTION Consider a situation of utter hopelessness and despair
B.	Consider something that will never change, never improve, never turn around, never get better
	"CAN THESE BONES LIVE?" Before an answer is given, consider 1. We throw bones away 2. Bones are a sign that life is over / all hope is gone
B.	Therefore, the logical, rational answer is "No. These bones cannot live"
C.	Reflect on the situation you previously considered
EZEK A.	IEL: "LORD, YOU KNOW" Interestingly, Ezekiel did not say, "No"
B.	Why did Ezekiel answer, "Lord, You know"?
C.	Why should we answer, "Lord, You know"? 1. God does not ask a question for which He does not have an answer 2. We need to give God the final word
	"PROPHESY TO THESE BONES" Prophesy = to speak through inspiration / divine influence
B.	Prophesy what? "Hear the word of the Lord" 1. I am going to put breath into you and make you live again! 2. I will put flesh and muscles on you and cover you with skin 3. I will put breath into you, and you will come to life 4. Then you will know that I am the Lord
C.	As I prophesied (rattling sound as bones came together, flesh, muscles and skin came on the skeletons)
D.	However, there was no breath in them (no breath, no life)
E.	Prophesy to the breath 1. "Thus says the Lord God: 'Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they may live" 2. So I prophesied, breath came into them, they lived, and stood on their feet, an exceedingly great army.

B.	We see dry bones, lost hope and shattered dreams
C.	God says, 1. "I will open your graves and bring you up from them"

2. "I will put My Spirit [breath] in you and you shall live"
