В.	 What is the value of abiding/living in Jesus? 1. John 15:4, ⁴ As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. 2. I produce in Jesus
C.	 What is the consequence of not abiding/living in Jesus? John 15:6, ⁶ If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. The difference between firewood and quality lumber I am not thrown away in Jesus
