PRAY WITHOUT CEASING

¹⁷ pray without ceasing (1 Thessalonians 5:17)

Have you ever been told, "If you pray for something more than once, you lack faith and trust in God."? I am sure that many of us were given that advice. Therefore, we were encouraged to "Take our burdens to the Lord and leave them there."

The question today, "Is praying for something more than once a lack of faith and trust in God?" I answer, "No," especially in the context of praying without ceasing or persistence in prayer. In 2 Corinthians 12:1-10, we find the story of Paul's Thorn in the Flesh. Note that Paul was a committed and dedicated man of God. Note also that Paul is one of the top 5 most significant characters in the New Testament. Note even more that Paul wrote almost half of the book in the New Testament. Therefore, if there is anyone in the New Testament who knew Jesus and had a personal and intimate relationship with Jesus, it was Paul.

However, in 2 Corinthians 12:1-10, Paul prays for the removal of the thorn in his flesh more than once. Following is the outline of the passage:

- A. Paul had a spiritual encounter where he was taken to the 3rd heaven
- B. Paul was given a thorn in the flesh to keep him humble
- C. Paul pleaded with the Lord three times for it to be removed
- D. Jesus' response, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness"
- E. Paul's response, "... for when I am weak, then I am strong"

Two things to consider from Paul's experience:

- 1. Paul prayed for the removal of the thorn three times. Are we, therefore, to conclude that Paul lacked faith and trust in God? Absolutely not. Perhaps Paul wanted God to know how serious he was regarding his request. Perhaps Paul wanted to have full confirmation of god's will ("God, it appears that you are saying 'No.' I am conforming that is what you are saying." Being persistent in prayer by praying for something more than once does not specifically mean that you lack faith and trust in God.
- 2. Although Paul was persistent in prayer because he prayed for the thorn more than once, Paul did not get the answer that he desired. Persistence in prayer is not a guarantee that you will get the things for which you are praying. Jesus answered Paul with the response that was best for Paul.

Yes, it is appropriate to remain persistent in pray by praying for the same thing more than once. Our faith and trust in God is not determined by how many times we pray. Rather, it is by how we resolve that God's will is always best.
