**TITLE: LIVING MY SPIRITUAL HERITAGE**

### INTRODUCTION

- A. The past two Sundays, we emphasized looking back to those who are in your spiritual heritage. Today, we will emphasize looking forward to those whose spiritual heritage you are in \_\_\_\_\_
- B. When you pour into someone else, you make room for God to pour more into you \_\_\_\_\_

### TAKE THEM WITH YOU (EXODUS 24:1, 2, 9-15)

- A. God called Moses, Aaron, Nadab, Abihu and the 72 elders to come up to Mt. Sinai and worship \_\_\_\_\_
- B. God called Moses to come up, near to God, to receive tablets written by God that he would teach to the people \_\_\_\_\_
- C. “Moses arose (set out) with his assistant Joshua” \_\_\_\_\_
  - 1. Wait here for us until we come back to you
  - 2. Joshua is not mentioned
  - 3. Moses had two sons: Gershom and Eliezer
  - 4. Moses was already going up the mountain
- D. Whom are you taking with you? \_\_\_\_\_
  - 1. This does not mean doing something different
  - 2. This means taking someone with you when you do it

### GIVE THEM RESPONSIBILITY (EXODUS 33:7-11)

- A. Moses used his tent as the tabernacle of meeting \_\_\_\_\_
- B. Moses went to the tabernacle of meeting and the LORD spoke with him face-to-face as one speaks to a friend \_\_\_\_\_
- C. Joshua did not leave the tabernacle of meeting \_\_\_\_\_
- D. To whom are you giving responsibility? \_\_\_\_\_

### GIVE THEM AUTHORITY (NUMBERS 27:12-22)

- A. God informed Moses that he would not take the people to the promised land \_\_\_\_\_
- B. Moses asks God to appoint someone to lead the people to the promised land \_\_\_\_\_
  - 1. Even though Moses knew he would not enter, his concern was for the fulfillment of the vision
  - 2. The vision God has given to you is bigger than you
- C. God selected Joshua (Are you surprised? If you are, you should not be) \_\_\_\_\_
- D. “Take Joshua (a man in whom is the Spirit)” \_\_\_\_\_
  - 1. Lay your hand on him
  - 2. Have him stand before Eleazar the priest and all the congregation and commission him in their sight
  - 3. You shall give him some of your authority, so that all the congregation of the Israelites may obey
- E. To whom are you giving some of your authority? \_\_\_\_\_
  - 1. What a blessing it is to see someone do what you have trained and equipped them to do
  - 2. When you give some of your authority to someone else, you do not lose anything
