- A. Some are in hopeless situations, communing with and depending on others in hopeless situations, hoping in a hopeless plan _____
- B. Far too many have placed their hope in that "something" they want to happen that will turn everything around for them
- C. We have been conditioned to believe that the answer to our problem is "over there." Therefore, if I can just get "over there."
