D.	Is there a consequence of using as an excuse, 'I don't know' and 'Not me'?
E.	What did Jesus say? 1. Jesus did not say, "I don't know." Jesus said, "Yes, I know." 2. Jesus did not say, "Not me." Jesus said, "Yes, me."
	If you faint in the day of adversity, your strength is small 1. Faint = Leave alone, let go, give up 2. Times of adversity reveal who we really are 3. What do I do? 4. Hebrews 12:12, 13, ¹² Therefore, strengthen your feeble arms and weak knees. ¹³ "Make level paths for your feet," so that the lame may not be disabled, but rather healed. (NIV) 5. What is my excuse?
В.	If you hold back from rescuing those taken away to death, those staggering to the slaughter 1. Hold back = Restrain from doing something 2. Taken away to death = Those innocently on their way to death (actually and metaphorically) 3. Staggering to the slaughter = Those in danger of being killed - the oppressed (actually and metaphorically) 4. Why do we hold back? We primarily hold back because of fear 5. What is my excuse?
C.	If you say, "Surely we did not know this" 1. "This is my excuse" 2. "I think that this is a sufficient excuse"
	God knows it 1. Does not he who weighs the heart perceive it?
P	2. Does not he who keeps watch over your soul know it? God will take care of it.
