ABRAHAM'S HARD DECISION

- A. After waiting for 25 years to have a son, God tests Abraham to sacrifice him back

ABRAHAM HAD A DESIRE TO TRUST THAT GOD WOULD PROVIDE

- A. Abraham had a spiritual view of the situation
 - 1. Abraham, "Isaac and I will go a little farther to worship and <u>we</u> will come back to you
 - 2. Hebrews 11:17-19, ¹⁷ It was by faith that Abraham offered Isaac as a sacrifice when God was testing him. Abraham, who had received God's promises, was ready to sacrifice his only son, Isaac, ¹⁸ even though God had told him, "Isaac is the son through whom your descendants will be counted." ¹⁹ Abraham reasoned that if Isaac died, God was able to bring him back to life again. And in a sense, Abraham did receive his son back from the dead.
 - 3. If God does take it or have it taken, do I have faith and trust that God will provide and give/get it back?
 - 4. A spiritual view sees God providing
- B. Abraham's spiritual view saw God, Himself, providing
 - 1. Isaac, "The fire and the wood are here, but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?"
 - 2. Abraham, "God himself will provide the lamb for a burnt offering, my son."
 - 3. God is intimate and God is personal
- C. God is Jehovah Jireh The Lord Will Provide when I am where I am supposed to be and doing what I am
