TITLE: LEADING BETWEEN THE ROCK AND THE HARD PLACE

1. INTRODUCTION

"Caught between a rock and a hard place," the saying goes. The rock and the hard place are of the same substance. They are both seemingly impenetrable.

DAVID'S HARD PLACE

Being afraid is a hard place
Needing to pretend is a hard place
Having to run and hide out is a hard place
Being in a place where you don't belong is a hard place
ACE YOU'RE IN DOESN'T HAVE TO BE IN YOU David takes cover in a cave, once again (Psalm 23 from a cave)
David looks over his experiences in hard places once again
David once again understands that the God he serves is a good God
David leads by writing this song while in his rock and hard place
Point: Our good work can be done when we are between a rock and a hard place

- 11. The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous...
- 12. His ears are attentive to their cry.
- 13. The righteous cry out and the Lord hears them.

- 15. The Lord is close to the brokenhearted.

"We've got some difficult days ahead," Martin Luther King, Jr., told an overflowing crowd in Memphis, Tennessee, on 3 April 1968, where the city's sanitation workers were striking.
