# PRAY, PRAY, PRAY THEN, WHAT ARE WE SUPPOSED TO DO, DO, DO?

In the past week, we have received distressing news regarding young people who were shot for making common, ordinary and unavoidable mistakes – for accidentally being in the wrong place that resulted in them being shot and one of them killed.

In Missouri, on Thursday, April 13, 2023, a Kansas City teen, Ralph Yarl, was shot twice after going to the wrong home to pick up his younger, twin brothers.

Last Saturday, April 15, 2023, a young lady, Kaylin Gillis, was riding with three other friends who were looking for a friend's house in upstate New York and was shot to death after the car she was riding in mistakenly drove onto the wrong driveway.

On Tuesday, April 18, 2023, a man shot and wounded two cheerleaders, Heather Roth and Payton Washington, in an Elgin, Texas supermarket parking lot after one of them said she mistakenly got into his car.

Also on Tuesday, April 18, 2023, a North Carolina man shot a 6-year-old girl, her parents and an additional neighbor after a basketball accidentally rolled into his yard.

What is at the foundation of this proliferation of violence for making common, ordinary and unavoidable mistakes? All of us at some point in our lives have rang the wrong doorbell, turned into the wrong driveway, went to the wrong car, etc.

When older and old adults are responding in violent ways to mistakes that others make, how can we expect children who are living with them and watching them to respond?

I am asking that we pray, pray, pray. Then, strategize what we (individually and as a church) are supposed to do, do, do.
