I GIVE TO A GIVING GOD

The Sermon Series for the month of October is titled, I Give To A Giving God. This series is based upon our Offertory Principle and Offertory Creed, which was developed in 2007. Following are our Offertory Principle and Offertory Creed:

OFFERTORY PRINCIPLE: When I increase my ability to handle it, God will increase my ability to have it

OFFERTORY CREED: I give to a giving God. God owns it all. Therefore, I will seek God first, give Him His, and He will give me the power to gain wealth; that I may also give to others.

THERE ARE THREE PRIMARY GOALS FOR THIS SERIES:

- ✓ To obey God and receive God's promises
 - God promised, "He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully... for God loves a cheerful giver." (2 Corinthians 9:6, 7)
 - God promised, "Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom." (Luke 6:38)
 - God promised to, "... open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it."
 (Malachi 3:10)
- ✓ **To work towards fulfilling the 10-10-80 Challenge** (Of my income, I will give 10% to God, save and/or invest 10% for myself and live off of the 80%)
- ✓ To encourage those in the 20-50-ish age group to begin tithing, and to teach the principles of tithing, saving and investing to their children

To assist in the fulfillment of these goals, please understand that giving is not a matter of finances; it is a matter of faith. Giving is not a matter of budgets; it is a matter of belief. Therefore, the question is not, "Can I afford to tithe?" Rather, the question is, "Can I afford <u>not</u> to tithe?"

Think about it, if these books posed no threat to them and the fulfilling of their agenda, they would not ban them.
