B.	Jesus loves you
	US IS THE WORD Word = logos = thought and word [The inward thought expressed or revealed through words]
B.	Jesus is God's Word [The Word of God – Revelation 19:13 , His name is called The Word of God.]
C.	Jesus is God's Word = God's <i>logos</i> = God's thought expressed or revealed 1. Before there are thoughts, there are words 2. Words are the expression or revelation of thoughts
D.	Jesus is the expression or revelation of God's thoughts 1. John 16:28 , ²⁸ I came forth from the Father and have come into the world 2. Just as our words come forth from our thoughts 3. If you want to know what I am thinking, listen to my words
E.	 If you want to know what God the Father is thinking, listen to Jesus Hebrews 1:3, ³ The Son radiates God's own glory and expresses the very character of God (NLT) John 5:19, ¹⁹the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner. John 6:38, ³⁸ For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.
	US – THE WORD – BECAME FLESH Jesus' Incarnation (Incarnate = in the flesh" (in = in and carnis = flesh)
B.	Jesus' miraculous conception (Ex. Artificial Insemination)
C.	Jesus' Hypostatic Union – The union of Jesus' divinity and humanity in one hypostasis 1. Philippians 2:6, 7 , ⁶ who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, ⁷ but

- 1. Under the Old Covenant (Exodus 33:7-11), the people went to the Tabernacle to meet God.
- 2. Under the New Covenant (Ezekiel 37:26-28), God, through the Word, came to Tabernacle with us.
- 3. When Jesus went back to the Father, He sent the Holy Spirit (John 14:16, 17) to dwell or Tabernacle within us. Therefore, we are the Tabernacle, that is, the dwelling place of God.
