INTRODUCTION

What is the meaning of the motto coined by Mary Church Terrell "lifting as we climb?" UJAMAA - In Swahili, UJAMAA can be taken to mean extended family, brotherhood, and, if

used in a political context, a form of solidarity. "Lifting as we climb."

V. GOD REDEEMS THE LOST - NAOMI THOUGHT HER FAMILY LINE HAD ENDED, BUT GOD CONTINUES IT THROUGH A KINSMAN-REDEEMER.

POINT: We must view our day-to-day lives as part of God's bigger plan for our lives and world. Out of Naomi and Ruth and Boaz's cooperation lifting, they lifted not only themselves up but so many others. In the very last verse of the book (4:22), it says that Ruth and Boaz's son, Obed, fathered Jesse, and Jesse's son was David. Jesus, being a direct descendent of David (Matthew 1:1), is therefore a direct descendant of Ruth and Boaz. Matthew 1:1-5 includes them in Jesus's genealogy.

VI. UJAMAA - It was Ujamaa practiced by Boaz, Ruth and Naomi that lifted as they climbed, UJAMAA, that lifted until the future brought down through the generations the One who said, "IF I BE LIFTED UP, I WILL DRAW ALL PERSONS UNTO ME!" Lifting as We Climb

1. **UJAMAA: Cooperative Economics**— "To build our own businesses, control the economics of our own community and share in all its work and wealth."

- 2. **UJAMAA**: is a commitment to the practice of shared social wealth and the work necessary to achieve it.
- 3. **UJAMAA**: also stresses self-reliance in the building, strengthening and controlling of the economics of our own community.
- 4. **UJAMAA**: "To build our own businesses, control the economics of our own community and share in all its work and wealth."
