	E DEVIL'S ATTACK  A. Jesus is persecuted – Herod  1. Luke 9:9 – Acknowledged beheading John; desired to see Jesus  2. Luke 13:31 – Pharisees tell Jesus that Herod wants to kill Him  3. Luke 23:11 – Pilate sent Jesus to Herod who ridiculed and mocked Him
	B. The church is persecuted – Herod
•	C. Peter is persecuted  1. Herod is emboldened after killing James – pleasing the people 2. Herod has Peter arrested, and placed in prison

	D'S RESPONSE – A PRAYING CHURCH A. Peter was kept in prison, but
	B. Constant prayer was offered to God for him by the church
	<ul> <li>C. Characteristics of the prayer  1. At least, a couple of days (the Passover was 7 days)  2. All day long, well into the night (Peter is sleeping; the church is praying)  3. Constant (<i>ektenēs</i> = stretched out)</li> </ul>
	D. What are the characteristics of our prayers?

1. Note: Peter is bound with 2 chains between 2 soldiers, with other soldiers (14) guarding the door
