Because some are dissatisfied with both candidates – exclaiming that one is too old and the other is unfit – they have suggested that they will "Sit this one out."

No, we cannot sit this one out. We must get in the game and fight.

- ✓ We cannot sit this one out when we have an activist supreme court that has no respect nor regard for precedent and long standing court decisions. We must get in the game and fight.
- ✓ We cannot sit this one out when The Project 2025 Presidential Transition Project (funded by the Heritage Foundation and more than 100 organizations) has developed a plan to enable a future anti-democratic presidential administration to take swift, far-right action that would cut wages for working people, dismantle social safety net programs, reverse decades of progress for civil rights, redefine the way our society operates, and undermine our economy. We must get in the game and fight.
- ✓ We cannot sit this one out when there are continued efforts to suppress, negate and nullify the votes of black and brown citizens of this country. We must get in the game and fight.
- ✓ We cannot sit this one out when black and brown immigrants are treated like animals and used as scapegoats for the country's problems. We must get in the game and fight.
- ✓ We cannot sit this one out when LGBTQ people are denied humane treatment and equal rights as every other human being is. We must get in the game and fight.
- ✓ We cannot sit this one out when some are willing to tear down all of the democratic norms and foundations of this country to gain and sustain power. We must get in the game and fight.

Those who have competed in team competitions know that there is a major distinction between what it feels like when your team has won the game and you were either in the game or on the bench. When your team won and you were on the bench, there was a feeling of happiness that you won, however, there is not the internal joy of know that your individual efforts contributed to the victory.

There is something about being in the game, touching the ball, getting sweaty and dirty. There is something about providing your individual efforts to contribute to the victory – knowing that you did something.

I am confident that the God of justice will ensure that justice is accomplished in this election. I am also aware that God is expecting us to do more than sit back and pray for God to move on our behalf. We must rise up, stand up, get in the game and fight.


