## TITLE: DO I BELIEVE IN JESUS?

### **INTRODUCTION**

- A. The Book of John is about believing in Jesus
  1. John 20:30, 31, <sup>30</sup> And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book: <sup>31</sup> But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.
  - 2. Do you believe in Jesus?
- B. In the Book of John, believing was associated with signs/miracles
- C. What was the sign/miracle that assisted in your believing in Jesus?

## **BELIEVING JESUS VERSUS BELIEVING IN JESUS**

- A. Believing Jesus is acknowledging and admitting the claims regarding Jesus
  - 1. James 2:19, <sup>19</sup> You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble!
  - 2. Matthew 4:3, 4, Devil, "If you are the Son of God, command these stones to become loaves of bread." Jesus, "But he answered, "It is written, 'One does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God. "" (NRSV)
- B. Believing in Jesus is trusting Jesus for your salvation and giving your whole self to Jesus for your eternal life and for your life here on earth.
  - 1. **1 John 5:13**, <sup>13</sup> These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life...
  - 2. John 11:25, 26, <sup>25</sup> Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in me, even though they die, will live, <sup>26</sup> and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do *vou believe this?"* (NRSV)
  - 3. Acts 16:31, <sup>31</sup> They answered, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household." (NRSV)

### TO THOSE WHO BELIEVE HIM

- A. If you abide in Jesus' Word (abide = to remain, to continue)\_\_\_\_
- B. First, you are really Jesus' disciple
- C. Second, you shall know the truth (Know = *ginosko* = to come to know)
- D. What truth? John 8:28-29, <sup>28</sup> Then Jesus said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things. <sup>29</sup> And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him."
- E. The truth shall make you free \_\_\_\_\_
- F. Therefore, if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.
