## TITLE: EATING TO LIVE VERSUS LIVING TO EAT:

WHY WE STILL CANNOT EAT IT
INTRODUCTION
A. Consider a story that appears to be about one thing – that has absolutely nothing to do with that thing –
rather, the story is being used to present a truth about another thing
B. Allegory: A story, poem or picture that can be interpreted to reveal a hidden meaning, typically a moral,
spiritual or political one.
WHAT HAPPENED THE DAY BEFORE?  A. Cornelius (A Gentile, centurion, devout man, God fearer, generous giver)
B. Cornelius had a vision to send men to Joppa to bring Peter. He sent two servants and one soldier (3 MEN) _
WHAT HAPPENED THE NEXT DAY?  A. Peter went up on the housetop at noon to pray
B. Then he became every hungry and wanted to eat
C. While they were preparing the food he fell into a trance  1. He saw a large sheet-like object descending from heaven 2. In it was all kinds of animals, reptiles, insects and birds 3. A voice said, "Rise Peter; kill and eat." 4. Peter said, "Not so, Lord! For I have never eaten anything common or unclean." 5. A voice said, "What God has cleansed you must not call common" 6. This was done 3 TIMES, and the object was taken up into heaven
<ul> <li>D. While Peter wondered what the vision meant (v. 17)</li> <li>1. Wondered = Thoroughly perplexed and to be in much doubt</li> <li>2. The 3 MEN Cornelius sent were at the gate asking for Peter</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>E. While Peter thought about the vision (v. 19, 20)</li> <li>1. Thought = To resolve in mind and to think upon</li> <li>2. The Spirit, "Get up, go down and <i>go with them</i>, without doubting</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>F. Explanation (v. 28):</li> <li>1. "You know it is unlawful for a Jewish man to associate with or visit a Gentile."</li> <li>2. "But God has shown me (through the vision) that <i>I should not call any man</i> common or unclean." (compare with verse 14)</li> </ul>
WHAT IS THIS ABOUT?  A. This story is not about food
B. This story is about accepting everyone, who was formerly seen as unacceptable, and inviting them into a
relationship with God through Jesus, the Christ
