TITLE: EATING TO LIVE VERSUS LIVING TO EAT:

WHY WE STILL CANNOT EAT IT

PROBLEM OBSERVED: UNWASHED HANDS
A. Religious leaders saw the Disciples eating with defiled (unwashed) hands
B. Pharisees and Jews do not eat unless:
1. They wash their hands in a special way
2. Holding the tradition of the elders
C. Returning from the marketplace, they do not eat w/o washing themselves
D. Also, many other things they observe: washing cups, pitchers, etc.
PROBLEM DEFINED: THE TRADITION OF THE ELDERS
A. The Disciples were not walking according to the tradition of the elders
B. Jesus' response:
1. Honor: They honored God with words, but not with their heart
2. Worship: Their worship was ineffective
3. Teaching: They taught as doctrine, human rules and ideas
4. They ignored God's commandments, and held on to human traditions
5. They cleverly sidestepped God's commandments, to keep their traditions
6. For example, Corban (A gift dedicated to God)
PROBLEM RESOLVED: DEFILEMENT COMES FROM WITHIN
A. There is nothing that enters a person from outside which defiles
B. The things which comes out of a person are the things that defile
C. Why?
1. It does not enter the person's heart
2. It enters the person's stomach and is eliminated
3. Therefore, the food is clean
4. What food? The food allowed by the law to be eaten although they had ceremonially unwashed
hands
5. From within, out of the heart proceeds
WHAT IS THIS ABOUT?
A. This is not about food
B. This is about honoring human traditions over the word of God
C. Living holy is not honoring external human rituals, but honoring God's word from the inside-out
