# TRACING A LEGACY OF LOVE

On March 16, 1968, Pilgrim Rest called The Reverend Leroy B. Mixon to serve as the second pastor of the church. As with Pastor Harrington, the motivations behind decisions Pastor Mixon made were in consideration of his love for and welfare of the Pilgrim Rest family. The love motivated by his decisions has created a legacy of love. We now live the legacy of his love and have a responsibility to ensure that the legacy continues for future generations to experience.

Pastor Mixon was called to serve at a difficult time in the life of the church. Because of his strong, confident passion for God and compassion for God's people, he restored faith and hope in the life of the congregation.

Pastor Mixon's love for God's Word was visibly manifested in his teaching and preaching. He was well known for his deep theological thought and his solid biblical exposition. His love for God's Word also opened doors for him to expand his teaching and preaching beyond the ears of his Pilgrim Rest family. His love for God's Word touched lives in the state through the Wisconsin General Baptist State Congress of Christian Education; in the country through the National Baptist Congress of Christian Education and throughout the world, including Mexico, Nigeria and Hong Kong.

As the congregation grew, Pastor Mixon was led to lead another building project and the church added a balcony in the sanctuary to provide adequate seating, a baptismal pool for new believers, and central air conditioning.

Pastor Mixon's love for God's Word was infectious and Pilgrim Rest was respected for its teaching ministry. Consequently, the church edifice on 8<sup>th</sup> Street was not large enough to facilitate his Christian Education vision. Through much prayer, God led Pastor Mixon to our third church edifice at 3737 North Sherman Boulevard on April 15, 1980. This edifice provided more than ample classroom space for children, youth and adults to have individual classrooms.

Pastor Mixon also erected a large cross on the front lawn of the Sherman Boulevard location to reflect the continuance of God's people in service. Pastor Mixon's desire was that everyone would see it and be reminded of the "Old Rugged Cross."

Because of his consistent concern for the well-being of the congregation, Pastor Mixon led the church to purchase a tract of land at 3752-3762 North 44<sup>th</sup> Street on February 1, 1986. The land was leveled, paved and landscaped to be used as our parking lot to facilitate 62 vehicles.

The sacrifices of love from Pastor Leroy and Sister Georgia Mixon will also be remembered and cherished. We remain resolved in our belief that we are who we are and where we are because of the legacy of love that was laid by them and those who were a part of the Pilgrim Rest family at that time, and commit to forever remember and share their stories and live their love.




#### PASTORAL TRANSITION PRAYER:
