2025 LENTEN SEASON

During this 2025 Lenten Season, we want to encourage everyone regarding the need to establish and maintain our hope in Jesus despite what is happening within our country. Too many are resting their expectations for the future upon what is happening in Washington, DC. Clearly, they need to know that there is hope – and, that hope is available through a relationship with Jesus, the Christ. Therefore, during the 2025 Lenten Season, I am encouraging us to use this season to establish, re-establish, continue to nurture and/or further deepen our relationship with Jesus.

The season of Lent is customarily accompanied with fasting. I am challenging us to spend these days fasting – that is, giving something up. I encourage us to do more than just giving up certain things for the 40 days of Lent, I encourage us to use the next 40 days to strip and cleanse ourselves of anything ungodly and/or unhealthy.

Additionally, I am also encouraging us to use the 40 days of Lent to establish life disciplines, as well as positive and beneficial goals for our lives that we, likewise, will continue after the season of Lent.

Think of it this way, for the 40 days of Lent, we have an opportunity to make life-long, lifestyle changes to produce overall, holistic health and well-being (spiritual, mental, emotional, physical, dietary, etc.) that we will continue for the rest of our lives. Examples include:

- Modifying our eating habits and committing to eating healthier foods.
- Modifying our sleeping habits.
- Exercising more and taking better care of our health.
- Drinking more water (note: not just liquids, but water)
- Identifying at least one ungodly and/or unhealthy action, attitude and activity and determine to give it up forever that we may be drawn closer to God and deeper in our intimacy with Him.
- Commit to attend Worship Service, Sunday School and Bible Study weekly
- Commit to daily Bible reading




PASTORAL TRANSITION PRAYER:
