

Souls to the Polls: AUGUST Actions

Protect the Post Office



On August 22, Souls to the Polls joined postal workers and other groups calling on Congress to protect postal services and keep mail-in voting safe from staff and operation cuts that have slowed mail delivery. These cuts have delayed prescriptions drugs, unemployment checks and other vital communication. The cuts were stopped finally but none of the damage is being repaired.

The Bucks and Brewers offer their home base for drive-through early voting

Fiserv Forum and Miller Park will be **early voting** locations with drive- thru voting. Fiserv Forum will be open from Oct. 20 through Nov. 1 from 8 a.m. through 7 p.m. on weekdays -- and from 10 a.m. through 4 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays. The hours for Miller Park have not been announced. Both will provide opportunities to register to vote if the person has proof of residence for the past 28 days. Athletes and owners have ensured that people can vote safely this November.

The Senior Voter Assistance project at City public housing sites for Senior citizens has been cancelled --for a **good** reason. The Election Commission has re-instated voting sites at these city housing units. They were removed in April and August, so residents needed support dealing with the absentee ballot process. Now, the voting sites are back downstairs for everyone and the absentee ballot is no longer a problem. We are looking at other ways of assisting seniors with absentee ballots at senior centers or other places where elders gather.

November 3, 2020 General Election

Polls will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on November 3, 2020.

Voter Registration Deadlines:

- October 14, 2020 - The deadline to register to vote online (by 11:59 p.m.) or by-mail (postmarked).
- October 30, 2020 at 5 p.m. - The deadline to register to vote at your clerk's office or other designated location.
- You can register at your polling place on Election Day (November 3, 2020).

Absentee By-Mail Deadlines:

- October 29, 2020 at 5 p.m. - The deadline to request an absentee ballot by-mail for regular and overseas voters.
- October 30, 2020 at 5 p.m. - The deadline to request an absentee ballot by-mail for indefinitely confined voters and military voters (not on active duty).
